## **FINAL NOTICE**

August 7, 2007

All Members & Contractors,

As per the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the contractors and the New York City District Council of Carpenters, effective July 1, 2007, all journeyman floor coverers working under this agreement must be INSTALL Certified in Carpet and Resilient Flooring. Contractors are required to hire Certified Floor Coverers only and the Union can only dispatch certified Floor Coverers to job site unless there are no certified members available. Fortunately at this time we are very busy and have not yet begun enforcing this. In the near future we will be replacing members who are not certified with members who are certified. Registering for certification and failing to attend class may result in being replaced on the job site. You also must call and re-register for certification.

The INSTALL Certification program is a national initiative with the full support of the UBC General Officers and many mills and manufactures. INSTALL Training is designed to produce the most highly skilled and uniformly trained floor coverers in the industry. INSTALL is also being used as a marketing and organizing tool to increase our market share throughout the country. INSTALL is a partnership and working together means more work for our contractors and our members.

As a reminder all floor coverers must take the OSHA 30 training before July 1, 2008.
